What is a Cookie?

Types of Cookies

We use different types of cookies to run our websites, some or all of the cookies identified in the list below may be stored in your browser. Cookies are divided into two categories:

- First-party cookies are created by the website you visit directly. For example, if you visit tweakyourface.com, the site will create cookies and save them to your computer.
- Third-party cookies are created by other parties, not our sites. We, like most other website owners, use online tools to create the content on our pages, some or all of which will also create a cookie and save it to your computer. As these cookies are not created by our site, they are classified as third-party cookies.

We need your consent to enable optional cookies, however also employ a series of strictly necessary cookies that are required for the basic functionalities of our website, and to deliver the service you requested from us.

On your first visit to this site, a pop up box with details on our use of cookies and the Cookie Notice will be presented. You will be able to accept all optional cookies on the site and close the pop up.
